

Bill Tracker 6/3/2020-6/5/2020

The Iowa Legislature resumed session June 3rd, after a 10 week suspension in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. When the legislators left, they were in the middle of the second funnel, since returning they have completed the second funnel and are now focusing primarily on passing a budget. Leadership in the House and Senate have expressed the intent to adjourn the 2020 legislative session by mid-June.
